RE: 56 Negus St. Fire

The Webster Police Department's Detective Bureau, in conjunction with Troopers assigned to the Massachusetts State Fire Marshal's Office, are actively investigating a suspicious fire that occurred at 56 Negus St. in the Town of Webster on the morning of June 4, 2010. The blaze was incendiary in nature, meaning that it was intentionally set. A Webster Firefighter was very seriously injured while fighting this fire.

The Webster Police Department and the Massachusetts State Fire Marshal's Office utilize a program known as the *ArsonWatch reward program*. The program pays a reward of up to \$5,000.00 for any information which helps detect or prevent an arson fire. All calls placed are held in strict confidence and the amount of reward is determined by the extent of information given.
